The reservation has been worked out as per Govt. Guidelines taking into account the excess/shortfall representation in SC/ST/OBC and PWD categories.

Abbreviations stand for: **SC-Scheduled Castes, ST-Scheduled Tribes, OBC-Other Backward Classes, GEN-General, PWD-Persons With Disability, OH-Orthopaedically Handicapped, HI-Hearing Impaired, VH-Visually Handicapped, EXSM-Ex-Servicemen.**

Note:

- Candidates belonging to reserved categories for which no vacancy has been announced are free to apply against vacancies announced for unreserved/General category provided they fulfill the age and qualification norms of General category.
- Application received for posts which are not advertised at all, or post not advertised in a particular state will not be entertained.
- The recruitment would be on State-wise basis. Candidates can apply for vacancies in one State only and have to appear for the examination from a centre of that particular State. As the reservation for OH/HI/VH and Ex-Servicemen candidates is on horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be recruited in the appropriate category to which the candidates belong.
- The number of vacancies as also the number of reserved vacancies are provisional and may change according to requirement of the Bank.
- It is clarified that it may not be possible to employ PWD candidates in all offices/branches of the bank and they in case of selection have to work in the post identified by the Bank as suitable for them.
- Candidate will be considered for appointment upon selection to vacancies at Branches/Offices located in the state for which he/she has applied for minimum period as prescribed by the Bank and request for transfer/posting to place outside the state would not be entertained by the Bank during this period under any circumstances. However, Bank reserves the right to post/transfer the candidate upon selection to any place in India depending upon requirement.
- In case sufficient candidates are not available for selection in a particular State, Bank reserves the right to select the candidates from other States where sufficient candidates are available and fill up the vacancies in the deficit State.

(2) Emoluments for the post of Clerical Cadre:

Pay Scale: Rs.4,410-13,210. (Under revision) Approx. total emoluments at the start of the scale will be Rs.7,000/-(approx.) inclusive of DA, CCA & HRA at Metropolitan Centre.

In addition Medical Aid, Hospitalisation Scheme, Leave Fare Concession, Retirement benefits are admissible as per Bank's rules.

(3) How to Apply:

Candidates are required to apply on-line through website www.centralbankofindia.co.in No other means/mode of applications will be accepted. Last date for receipt of system generated printout of the applications is **23/03/2009**. Application link from website will be open from **14/02/2009 to 14/03/2009**.

The guidelines for filling applications on-line is given as under:

- The candidate should have their Demand Draft ready before applying on-line, as the DD details are required to be entered in the on-line application. Without the valid DD details, data will not be registered. The DD should not be dated before **14/02/2009** and not after **14/03/2009**. Even if the Bank extends the date of on-line registration by one or two days, the valid dates of demand draft will not be changed.
- After applying on-line, the registered candidates should obtain a system generated printout of the application. The system generated printout of the application should be signed by the candidate and sent along with:
 - The application fees in the form of DD favouring "Central Bank of India - Recruitment of Clerks 2009" payable at Mumbai for **Rs. 50/-** (Fifty only) for SC/ST/PWD/EXSM candidates and **Rs. 250/-** (Two hundred & fifty only.) for other candidates.

- The candidate must possess a valid Email id for filling the application.
- In case a candidate is not having a valid id, he can create a new email id.
- The candidate must retain the photocopy of the sent printout of the application form for further reference.
- Only those registered applications, the printout of which is received duly signed along with DD, certificates and photographs pasted will be treated as valid. The Bank will not be responsible for any postal delay or loss in transit.

(4) Eligibility Criteria:

A) Educational Qualification: (As on 01/01/2009)

Degree in any discipline from a Recognized University or any equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Central Government.

OR

A pass with 50% marks in HSC examination of 10+2 (10+2+3) pattern/11th Std. of (11+1+3) pattern or Intermediate/Pre-University or any equivalent examination/Diploma in Banking recognized by Central/State Government or U.T. administration.

OR

A pass with 60% marks in the aggregate in Matriculation/SSC (old pattern)/SSLC/10th Std. examination of 10+2+3 pattern or equivalent.

For SC/ST/EX-Servicemen/PWD, the educational qualification is relaxed as below:

A pass in HSC examination (10+2) of 10+2+3 pattern/11th Std. examination of 11+1+3 pattern/Pre-University or equivalent examination.

OR

A pass with 50% marks in the aggregate in matriculation/SSC (old pattern) SSLC/10th Std. in (10+2+3) pattern or equivalent examination.

Note:

- For Ex-Servicemen (who do not possess the above) a pass in service (Departmental) Examination which is recognized to civil examination not below the rank of Higher Secondary School Examination.
- All Educational Qualifications should be from Recognized University/Central/State/U.T. Administration.
- Should be able to write and speak English fluently.
- Knowledge to read, write and speak the official language of the state for which the candidate has applied is essential.
- Computer Literacy- Apart from relevant qualification for the above post, computer literacy shall be an essential qualification, which the candidate must either possess or acquire within six months of joining the Bank.

DEFINITION OF EX-SERVICEMEN (EXSM)

- EX-SERVICEMEN(EXSM):** Only those candidates shall be treated as Ex-servicemen who fulfill the revised definition as laid down in Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms Notification No.36034/5/85 Estt. (SCT) dated 27.1.86 as amended from time to time.
- DISABLED EX-SERVICEMEN(DISEXSM):** Ex-servicemen who while serving in Armed Forces of the union were disabled in operation against the enemy or in disturbed areas shall be treated as DISEXSM.
- DEPENDENTS OF EX-SERVICEMEN KILLED IN ACTION (DXSM):** Ex-Servicemen killed in the following operations would be deemed to have been killed in action attributable to military service (a) war (b) war like operations or Border skirmishes either with Pakistan on cease fire line or any other country (c) fighting against armed hostiles in a counter insurgency environment viz: Nagaland, Mizoram, etc. (d) serving with Peace Keeping Mission abroad (e) laying or clearance of mines including enemy mines as also mine sweeping operation between one month before and three months after conclusion of an operation (f) frost bite during actual operations or during the period specified by the Government (g) dealing with agitating para-military forces personnel (h) IPKF Personnel killed during the operations in Sri Lanka.

NOTE: (1) Candidates still serving in Defence Services and desirous of applying under Ex-Servicemen category should submit a certificate from the Competent Authority to the effect that they would be released / retired on or before **31/03/2009**.

(2) Ex-Servicemen candidates who have already secured employment under the Central Government in Group 'C' & 'D' will be permitted the benefit of age relaxation as prescribed for Ex-Servicemen for securing another employment in a higher grade or cadre in Group 'C/D' under the Central Government. However, such candidates will not be eligible for the benefit of reservation for Ex-Servicemen in Central Government jobs.

RESERVATION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITY

Reservation is available to Persons with disability. Persons under Section 33 of the Persons With Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act 1995. Accordingly, candidates with the following disabilities are eligible to apply. Applicants claiming such benefits should produce certificate in original in support of their claim at the time of interview.

Definition:

Visually Handicapped (VH)

- Blindness refers to condition where a person suffers from any of the following conditions namely (i) Total absence of sight, (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses. (iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending in angle of 20 degree or worse.
- Low vision means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive connection but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning of execution of a task with appropriate assistive device.

Hearing Impaired (HI)

Hearing impaired means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.

Orthopaedically Handicapped (OH)

1. Locomotor Disability means disability of bones, joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy.

2. Cerebral Palsy means a group of non-progressive conditions of person characterized by abnormal motor control posture resulting from brain insult or injuries occurring in the pre-natal, peri-natal or infant period of development.

All the cases of Orthopaedically Handicapped Persons would be covered under the category of 'Locomotor disability or cerebral palsy'. Only such persons would be eligible for reservation in services/posts who suffer from not less than 40 percent or relevant disability.

As the reservation of PWD candidates is on horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be placed in the appropriate category (SC/ST/OBC/General) to which they belong.

Wherever the written examination is held the blind candidates and candidates whose writing speed is affected by cerebral palsy can use own scribe at their cost during the written examination. In all such cases, where a scribe is used the following rules will apply.

- The candidate will have to arrange his own scribe at his own cost.
- The academic qualification of the scribe should be one grade lower than the stipulated criteria i.e. the scribe's educational qualification should be less than HSC.
- The scribe should possess less marks than the candidates and not more than 60% marks in his own academic stream.
- The scribe may be from any academic stream.
- Both the candidates as well as scribes will have to give a suitable undertaking confirming that the scribe fulfils all the stipulated eligibility criteria for a scribe mentioned above. Further in case it later transpires that he did not fulfill any laid down eligibility criteria or suppressed material facts the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the result of the written test.
- Such candidates who use a scribe shall be eligible for extra time of 20 minutes for every hour of the examination.

B) Age (As on 01/01/2009): Min.: 18 Years, Max.: 28 Years

Note: In case of a candidate who is eligible for relaxation under more than one of the above categories, the age relaxation will be available on cumulative basis with any one of the remaining categories for which age relaxation is permitted as mentioned above. This cumulative age relaxation is available to SC/ST/OBC candidates only.

(5) Probation: On appointment, candidates will be on probation for a minimum period of 6 months. On successful completion of the probation, and if found suitable, they will be confirmed in the services of the Bank.

(6) Selection Procedure

Selection will be made on the basis of performance in Written Test and Interview. Details of Written Test and Interview are as under:

A) Written Test:

- Objective Tests:** The Objective tests consists of (i) Test of Reasoning Ability (ii) Test of English Language (iii) Test of Numerical Ability (iv) Test of Clerical Aptitude. There will be negative marks for the wrong answers in the objective test. The candidates shall be required to qualify in the objective test separately. Test of English is qualifying and carries no Weightage in the total marks for the Written Test. **The time duration will be 95 minutes and each Test will be of 50 Questions.**
- Descriptive Test-** It will consist of 5 compulsory questions with internal options, to assess knowledge on Socio-Economic Developments and Communication Skills. The descriptive test is only a qualifying test.
- Candidates have option to answer Descriptive Test paper either in English or Hindi or in the Official Language of the State/Union Territory for which they have applied.
- Candidates have to pass in each of the Objective & Descriptive Tests separately.
- Depending upon the number of candidates against the vacancies only those candidates, who rank sufficiently high in the objective test will be called for interview. Mere eligibility/pass in the test shall not vest any right in a candidate for being called for interview.
- Other detailed information regarding the written examination will be given in the information booklet, which will be made available to the candidates along with the call letter.

B) Interview:

Those short listed candidates in the order of ranking in the written test as per the cut-off marks determined by the Bank shall be called for interview and the decision of the Bank in this regard shall be final.

Final selection will be on the basis of the ranking accorded after adding the marks obtained in the Written Test and Interview.

(7) Pre-Examination Training:(For SC/ST/EXSM/PWD/Minority Community Candidates only):

It is proposed to impart Pre-Examination Training to a limited number of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes/PWD/EXSM/Minority Communities at some centres. All eligible candidates who wish to avail to Pre-examination training should fill in the relevant column in the ON-LINE APPLICATION. All expenses regarding travelling, boarding, lodging etc. will be borne by the Candidate for attending the pre-examination training programme at the concerned Centres.

(8) Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct:

Candidates are advised in their own interest that they should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered, fabricated or suppress any material information while filling in the application form and submitting the certified copies /testimonials:

At the time of written examination/interview, if a candidate is (or has been) found guilty of:

- Using any unfair means during the examination or
- Impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or
- Misbehaving in the examination hall or
- Taking away the question booklet/answer sheet from the examination hall or
- Resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for selection or
- obtaining support for his/her candidature by any means, such a candidate may in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:

(a) to be disqualified from the examination for which he/she is a candidate

(b) to be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period from any examination or recruitment conducted by Bank/IBPS

- The Bank/IBPS would be analyzing the responses of a candidate with others who appeared
- Candidates to detect unusual/patterns of responses. If as per the laid down procedure, it is suspected that the responses have been shared and the score obtained are not genuine/valid, the Bank reserves the right to cancel his candidature.

(9) **Important General Instructions:**

a. The Bank is free to reject any application at any stage of recruitment process, if the candidate is found ineligible for the post. The decision of the Bank in any matter relating to recruitment at all the stages of the recruitment process will be final and binding upon the candidate. The Bank in this regard shall entertain no correspondence or personal queries.

b. Only candidates willing to serve anywhere in India need apply.

c. Any disputes arising out of this advertisement shall be subject to the sole jurisdiction of courts situated at Mumbai only.

d. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.

e. All candidates will have to produce, if called for interview, original as well as attested photocopies of their educational and experience certificate as well as caste certificate, certificate of handicapped or any other certificates in support of their eligibility, failing which their candidature will be cancelled.

f. In case of candidate belonging to OBC category, the certificate inter-alia must specify that the candidate does not belong to " CREAMY LAYER" section excluded from the benefit of reservation for OBC in Civil post and services under Government of India. The OBC certificate containing " Non Creamy Layer Clause" should be based on income for the financial year 2007-08 and issued on or after 01/04/2008.

g. Candidates serving in Government/Quasi Government Offices/Public Sector Undertaking including Nationalized Bank and financial institution will be required to submit " No Objection Certificate" from the employer at the time of interview failing which the candidature may not be considered.

h. The candidates will have to appear for written test and interview at their own expense. However, eligible (as per extant government guidelines) SC/ST/PWD outstation candidates attending the interview will be reimbursed to-and-fro second-class ordinary train/bus fare by the shortest route on production of evidence of travel.

i. Any request for change of address will not be entertained.

j. In case of any dispute on account of interpretation in any version other than English, the English version shall prevail.

- (ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate.
- (iii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- (iv) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.

For Persons With Disability
Authorized Certifying Authority will be Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or the State Government consisting of at least three members out of which at least one shall be specialist in the particular field of disability from which the person is suffering.

(11) Call Letters for the Written Examination:
The date of the Written Test is **24/05/2009 (Sunday)**. The date of written test will be intimated in the call-letter along with the Centre/Venue for the examination.

Candidates who do not receive call-letter by **16/05/2009** Should contact in person at the address for the respective Centres given in Annexure 'A' along with copy of Application, Registration No.
